





The Law "On Media" Entered into force on 8 February 2022



The Law distinguishes 4 types of media entities:

Audiovisual media entities

to be licensed by



- Online media entities
- Print media entities
- **Information Agencies**





Members of the Audiovisual Council

- Members are appointed by the President for 5 years
- Members can be appointed for a maximum 2 consecutive terms
- Chairperson is elected by the members by a simple majority of the votes





Main functions of the Audiovisual Council

- policy-making;
- carrying out competitions;
- licensing;
- radio frequency planning;
- technical supervision of the broadcasting;
- monitoring of audiovisual content;
- permitting foreign channels to be broadcast via "AzerSpace" satellites;
- imposing sanctions;
- media literacy activity

Monitoring of content:

On daily basis

National TV & Radio channels

On the basis of complaints

- > Regional TV & radio channels,
- > Platform broadcasters,
- > On-demand media providers



Monitoring of retransmission packages:

On regular basis:

- > Platform operators
- > Multiplex operators



The Audiovisual Council can:

- √ issue warning to broadcaster or operator;
- √ suspend broadcasting for 1-24 hours;
- √ suspend broadcasting for 1-30 days;
- √ apply financial penalty ≈ 2000 6000 US\$;
- √ suspend the License;
- √ revoke the License.







"Radio Television Broadcasting & Satellite Communications" PA (TELERADIO)

- Digital terrestrial transmission of FTA television channels;
- Analog terrestrial transmission of FTA radio channels;
- DAB+ digital terrestrial transmission in Baku;
- Uplink services for TV and radio broadcasters;
- Delivering of initial TV and radio signals to multiplex, platform and satellite operators;
- Development of DVB-T2 and DAB+ broadcasting.




- Revision of the Law "On Telecommunications" (2025)

- Combatting piracy in retransmission system



Receiving of television signals




Television Audience Measurement system supported by
