
Mission, Vision and Members

- RTÜK was founded in 1994 as an impartial public legal person for the purpose of regulating and supervising the sector of radio, television and on demand media services.
- RTÜK is an independent regulatory authority with its own administrative and financial autonomy.
- The Supreme Council is composed of 9 members.
- Term of each Supreme Council Member is six years.
- President and Deputy President are elected from among the Supreme Council Members for a period of 2 years.







Daily Average Time Spent on Media

















Media Usage Rates of Young People

Average Daily Usage Times









News Resources of the Youngsters

Level of trust in news sources. (Average Point)







Young people rely on social media the most as a source of news!

Distribution of Social Media Account Ownership (%)


Is Your Social Media Profile Public? (%)

EMOTIONAL AND PHYSICAL EFFECTS OF DIGITAL DEVICE USE


The research was conducted laboratories in 17 metropolitan cities with the participation of 3,230 4th grade students of elementary schools having equipped computer laboratories

Emotional Effects

64.6% of students feel unhappy, and 48.5% feel angry after they put down their devices

Sleeping Pattern

13.6% of the students stated that they <u>always</u> fall asleep in front of the screen, and 53.9% stated that they <u>sometimes</u> fall asleep.



Physical Exhaustion

64.5% of those surveyed stated that they experienced fatigue after using digital devices

Urge to Reuse

40.8% of students feel the urge to use the device again within an hour after turning it off.

RTÜK Institutional Activities

Monitoring Broadcasts

We detect harmful content and apply the necessary sanctions.

Public Service Announcements

We are preparing public service announcements to raise awareness against bullying.

3 Educational Broadcasts

We encourage contents that teach values such as empathy and solidarity..

Collaborations with Digital Media Services

We carry out anti-bullying projects with digital platforms.






Sanctions

- 1. Abusing and harming the development of children, or orienting children to purchase a product or a service (563 times)
- 2. Broadcasts damaging the development of children (138 times)
- 3. Broadcasts inciting and encouraging violence (25 times)
- 4. Discrimination against race, language, religion, gender (12 times)
- 5. Praising offense, criminal and crime syndicate (5 times)
- 6. Broadcasts consisting abuse against children and harestment (3 times)
- 7. **10 times** administrative fines and **8 times** catalogue removals imposed due to the violations of digital/virtual advertisement implementations





Legal Foundation:

"Regulation on the Procedures and Principles for the Encouragement of Family and Child-Friendly Productions and Series" entered into force after being published in the 8 May 2018 dated Official Gazette no.30415

Rewarding and Supporting

Incentive Awards are to be given in the categories of TV series, movies, news, documentaries, children's programs, sports programs, competitions, news productions, science, arts, cultural and entertainment programs.

Protecting Children From Harmful Content

Parental Control Tools

Protective Smbols

Symbols are used to classify content according to age groups.

Child Profile

Separate profiles can be created that offer safe content particularly for children.

PIN/Password Application

Access to certain content requires a PIN code or password.

Content Restriction

There are filters that block out certain content





Public Service Announcements for Children

Between 2022 and 2024, a total of 38 public service announcements targeting children were broadcast on TV and 21 public service announcements were broadcasted on radio.





