

Country Report – Bulgaria

BRAF FORUM, SEPTEMBER 2025

Institutional Developments

- ▶ **Dr. Simona Veleva elected Chair** (22 April 2025, one-year term)
- New procedure for election of BNT Director-General → vote scheduled: 16 October 2025
- ▶ Semi-annual report of BNR Director-General adopted (July 2025)

Monitoring

- Extensive monitoring of linear & non-linear media services
- ► Focus on public service broadcasters
 - Pluralism of viewpoints in news and current affairs (Horizont & BNT1)
 - Compliance with national & regional licensing (BNR has 9 regional programmes)

Licensing

- ▶ Almost 60% of radio licences expiring in 2025–2026 (25-year term)
- Renewal tied to monitoring of licensing parameters
- Decisions:
 - 43 radio licences extended
 - 3 television licences extended
 - 3 new audiovisual services registered
 - 4 inactive providers deregistered

Thematic Monitoring

- Coverage of the Israel-Iran war
- Coverage of fatal incidents involving children
- Product placement & surreptitious commercial communications in reality shows
- Compliance with advertising volume limits
- **Results:** 13 administrative violations \rightarrow 10 sanctioning decisions

Research

- Nationwide survey on audiences & expectations of Bulgarian public service broadcasters (BNT & BNR)
- Methods: expert interviews, focus groups, representative poll (1,382 citizens)

▶ Findings:

- Public mission remains central
- Expected roles: informational, cultural-educational, entertaining
- Clear majority satisfied with performance
- Younger generations increasingly seek digital access

International Cooperation

- Active role in European Board for Media Services (EBMS)
 - 20+ working group meetings in 2025
 - Serving as a drafter in one workstream

National Legislative Work

- ► CEM representatives in Ministry of Culture working group
 - Task: Preparing amendments to the Radio and Television Act
 - Goal: alignment with EMFA

CEM's Priorities

- Protection of minors
- ► Countering disinformation
- **▶** Effective election monitoring
- Strengthening media literacy
