

CASE 1: NEGATIVE DISCRIMINATION

On one of the channels TV host said:

«I would not agree to my son marrying a girl who does not have father»

This expression violated the article of the “Law on Media”
(gender, racial, religious or other forms of discrimination should not be promoted)

The broadcast of this channel was suspended for **24 hours**
by ACRA

CASE 2: POSITIVE DISCRIMINATION

On a TV channel, a short video showed a schoolgirl being beaten by classmates of the same gender. The faces of the children were not blurred. The incident happened in a residential area outside the city.

After the video the TV host said:

“This is unacceptable. I don’t believe a local person from that area did this. I think the children’s families moved there later and are not local”.

In this broadcast, two rules were broken:

1. The faces of minors were not hidden.
2. The host made statements that promoted discrimination based on gender, origin or other factors, which is not allowed.

The broadcast of this channel was suspended for **8 hours** by ACRA

CASE 3: ABSTRACT DISCRIMINATION

During a TV program, as a guest spoke about the traditions and customs of the Hindu people, the host reacted by saying: 'We shouldn't be stuck in the mindset of the Hindu people. We need to make some progress'.

In this case, an instance of racial discrimination occurred and such acts are considered unacceptable under the law.
